
13 WHEREAS, changes in technology require additional training for the Department's computer

FISCAL NOTE

AMEND SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT 2003 BUDGET FOR EXPENDITURE OF SEIZED FUNDS

Enrolled Ordinance 141-41 (1986) authorized the Sheriff's Department to participate in a program, which transfers forfeited property to those state and local agencies, which contributed directly to the seizure of that property to be used for law enforcement purposes. The Sheriff's Department receives funds from the Federal government and acts as a trustee for a portion of these funds on behalf of participating agencies. Federal guidelines require that seized funds must be used to enhance law enforcement activities, not to supplant existing adopted budget appropriations.

This ordinance authorizes the appropriation of \$3,600 for training the Department's computer forensic investigator as allowed by the federal guidelines for asset forfeitures. The current unallocated balance of seized funds is \$87,018. After appropriating the requested \$3,600, the remaining \$83,418 will be available for future use. The remaining seized funds would require appropriation through future ordinances or the budget process in order to be expended.
