

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 160-24

APPROPRIATE FUND BALANCE TO FUND A LAND INFORMATION
DIVISION CONVERSION COMPUTER PROGRAM

WHEREAS the Land Information System Division of the Parks and Land Use Department maintains tax parcel maps for the entire area of Waukesha County except for the City of Waukesha, and

WHEREAS the City of Waukesha maintains tax parcel maps for the area encompassed by the City, and

WHEREAS the Land Information System Division of the Parks and Land Use Department has converted their base mapping applications to a GeoDatabase format which does not provide for direct importing of City of Waukesha tax parcel map information, and

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the County to obtain the City of Waukesha tax parcel information in a timely manner for use in the Land Information System, and

WHEREAS the City of Waukesha has agreed to provide the City of Waukesha tax data to the County for use in the Land Information System, and

WHEREAS a computer program must be developed to provide for the conversion and importing of City of Waukesha tax parcel map information into the Waukesha County Land Information Program, and

WHEREAS such a computer program will be used to import current tax parcel data from the City of Waukesha whenever changes are made to the data by the City, and

WHEREAS such a computer program will assist the Waukesha County Parks and Land Use Department in the future acquisition and processing of digitally prepared land division plats, and


WHEREAS the Land Information System Division Fund Balance has sufficient funds to cover the development of the required conversion computer program.


