

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 160-4

AMEND 2005 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET
EXPENDITURE OF SEIZED FUNDS
APRIL 2005

WHEREAS, enrolled ordinance 141-41 authorizes the Sheriff's Department "... to participate in the program to transfer federally seized property to local enforcement agencies", and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department has such assets that had not been allocated during the 2005 budget process, and

WHEREAS, the Department has identified expenditures to enhance law enforcement in Waukesha County as required by federal seized asset guidelines, and


WHEREAS, the department has agreed to allocate a percentage of assets received to participating Metro Unit agencies.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that federal seized asset funding of \$63,833 received and reserved in General Fund balance as of 12/31/04 be appropriated to the Sheriff's 2005 budget by increasing Other Revenues by the \$63,833, increase Operating Expenses by \$61,400 for law enforcement equipment purchases to enhance law enforcement efforts in the County, and by increasing Operating Expense appropriations by \$2,433 for the distribution to participating Metro Drug Unit agencies in accordance with federal seized asset funding guidelines.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that \$18,171 of federal seized asset funding received in 2005 be appropriated to the Sheriff's 2005 budget by increasing Other Revenues by \$18,171 and by increasing Operating Expense appropriations by \$18,171 for the distribution to participating Metro Drug Unit agencies in accordance with federal seized asset funding guidelines.
