

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 161-83

ENDORSE THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF FEDERAL
FUNDS FOR SERVING SENIORS WITH VISION LOSS

WHEREAS the Waukesha County Federated Library System (WCFLS) has received Federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) grant funds from the state Department of Public Instruction (DPI) in the amount of \$14,140, for a project titled Serving Seniors with Vision Loss, and

WHEREAS, these LSTA grant funds will be used to improve library services to senior citizens with vision loss with a focus on how to download electronic books and how to use the players that are replacing compact disc and tape players, and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County budget for the Federated Library System does not include this grant, intent, or awarded funding, and

WHEREAS, the proposed use of the grant funds has no direct impact on either the County General Levy or the Special Library Levy.


