ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2006
PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
2007 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND
EXPENDITURES FOR CITIZEN CORP INITIATIVES

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2006 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is available to the Urban Area agencies, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI included a funding request for the enhancement of citizen participation and preparedness for disaster or terrorism events through public education materials and training opportunities, and

WHEREAS, Waukesha County will contract with another entity to provide training opportunities to interested citizens and philanthropic organizations as well as assist with the development of planning guidelines for the volunteers and their families, and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee and Waukesha Counties will jointly purchase a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) trailer which will be taken to community training events in both counties, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance approved the investment justifications, allocated funding and authorized Waukesha County to submit grant applications for these projects.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WAUKESHA COUNTY DOES ORDAIN that the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office be authorized to accept \$248,050 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Emergency Preparedness budget be modified by increasing the Intergovernmental Grant revenue appropriation by \$248,050, and increasing the Operating Expense appropriation by \$240,608 and the Interdepartmental Charge appropriation by \$7,442.
