

ORDER CREATING SILVER LAKE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREFORE on September 19, 2007, a verified petition was filed with the Waukesha County Clerk requesting the establishment of a public inland lake protection and rehabilitation district to be known as the Silver Lake Management District and was accompanied by a map and a description indicating the area and boundaries of the proposed district, and

WHEREFORE the Waukesha County Land Use, Parks and Environment Committee held a public hearing on October 16, 2007 pursuant to §33.26 Wis. Stats. and various comments were received and have been recorded in a report submitted to the County Board by the committee.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA makes the following order:

Based on the report of the Waukesha County Land Use, Parks and Environment Committee holding the hearing on the matter, this Board finds and concludes:

1. That the petition filed September 19, 2007 was signed by at least 51% of the landowners in the proposed district.
2. That the public inland lake protection and rehabilitation district is necessary in order to define the present and anticipated problems of Silver Lake and to identify the causes of those problems, to implement various remedial measures to deal with the problems and to undertake activities such as protection of the fishery, management of aquatic plants and the reduction of sedimentation.
3. That the public health, comfort, convenience, necessity or public welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the Silver Lake Management District.
4. That property finally included in the district will be benefited by establishment thereof.
5. That formation of a district will not cause or contribute to long-range environmental pollution as defined by §299.01(4) Wis. Stats.

Based on the above findings and conclusions,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Pursuant to §33.24 Wis. Stats., a public inland lake protection and rehabilitation district is hereby established to include the area generally described as:

All properties around Silver Lake that are located in the Town of Summit that have riparian rights to Silver Lake, including those properties without lake frontage that have deeded access rights to Silver Lake and contiguous properties to the above mentioned areas that include significant wetland and groundwater recharge areas that feed Silver Lake.

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The district boundary is as illustrated in Exhibit "A."

- 2. The district shall be a body corporate and shall have all such powers as are authorized by Chapter 33, Wisconsin Statutes, and shall be known as the Silver Lake Management District.


