

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 162-96

ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY-URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY2006  
PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE 2008 CAPITAL BUDGET TO  
CREATE CAPITAL PROJECT 200828 VHF OVERLAY

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, along with the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2006 Homeland Security-Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funding is awarded to cooperating Urban Area agencies, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security and the Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance approved the investment justifications, awarded allocated funding of \$615,000 for this purpose, and authorized Waukesha County to submit grant applications to go forward with implementation of this project, and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Justice and Law Enforcement Committee reviewed the Emergency Management intent to apply documentation for this grant project, and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee UASI partners included a funding request for Waukesha County to enhance the County's interoperable communication system through the installation of a VHF (very high frequency) radio overlay to provide a communication interface between the County's 800MHz radio system and any mutual aid response that may use VHF radio technology, and

WHEREAS, grant funding is awarded to the County for equipment to be installed at existing Waukesha County 800 MHz trunked tower sites to provide portable radio coverage for selected VHF interoperability channels.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS THAT the Waukesha County Emergency Preparedness Department-Emergency Management Office is authorized to accept \$615,000 of Federal Homeland Security grant funding.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the County's 2008 Adopted Capital Project Budget be modified to create project 200828 VHF radio overlay with Intergovernmental Grant revenue of \$615,000 and corresponding expenditure appropriations of \$615,000.


