

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 163-76

REPEAL AND RECREATE WAUKESHA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO SET FEES FOR RIGHT OF WAY PERMITS

WHEREAS Chapter 15 of the Waukesha County Code provides for right-of-way permit fees and governs the issuing of permits, and

WHEREAS fees need to be increased for 2009, based on increasing direct labor costs associated with issuing the permits.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 15-2 of the Code of Ordinances of the County of Waukesha, Wisconsin, is repealed and recreated so that the fees listed in that section shall be increased to the following:


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon approval and publication.


SECTION 4. Any code section or part of a section in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.
