ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY - FY2009 PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2010 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR MAINTENANCE AND ADMINISTRATION OF MILWAUKEE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE PARTICIPATION

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security designated Waukesha County, the City of Milwaukee, and Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine and Washington Counties as an Urban Area eligible for grant funding through the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) to enhance the capabilities to prevent, respond to, recover from, and mitigate against all-hazard emergency and disaster situations including natural or man-made disasters or emergencies, and

WHEREAS, federal fiscal year 2009 Homeland Security - UASI grant funding is available to Waukesha County specifically to support the administration and maintenance of Waukesha County's participation in the Milwaukee UASI program, including attendance at the 2010 UASI Shared Strategies Conference in Denver, Colorado.



ACCEPT FISCAL NOTE

HOMELAND SECURITY-FY2009 PROGRAM FUNDING AND MODIFY THE  
EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 2010 BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE GRANT  
REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR MAINTENANCE AND ADMINISTRATION OF  
MILWAUKEE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE PARTICIPATION

This ordinance requests the 2010 Emergency Preparedness-Disaster Management program budget be modified to include \$5,000 of federal Homeland Security grant award funds to support the County's participation in the Milwaukee Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI). The purpose of the Initiative is to enhance area capabilities to prevent, respond to, recover from and mitigate against all-hazard emergency and disaster situations, including both natural and man-made disasters or emergencies..

According to the Emergency Management Department, \$3,750 of the grant funds are to be used to pay the County's participation in at the 2010 UASI Shared Strategies Conference in Denver, Colorado and \$1,250 for various office supplies and small equipment used in administering the UASI program.

This grant results in no additional direct tax levy impact in 2010.
