

ENROLLED ORDINANCE 166-25

AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF WAUKESHA COUNTY BY CREATING
TWO NEW SECTIONS PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LAND
INFORMATION COUNCIL, ASSIGNING DUTIES OF A LAND
INFORMATION OFFICE, AND REPEALING SECTION 6-26

WHEREAS, on June 19, 1990, the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors created a Land Information Office as authorized through Section 59.72 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, a Land Information Office is responsible for coordinating land information projects within the County, between the County and local governmental units, between the State and local governmental units and among the local governmental units, the Federal government and the private sector; and

WHEREAS, the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors adopted Enrolled Ordinance No. 155-99 on January 23, 2001, establishing an Intergovernmental Land Information Advisory Board to provide guidance for the Land Information Office; and

WHEREAS, Section 59.72(3m) of the Wisconsin Statutes now requires if a County has established a land information office, the Waukesha County Board of Supervisors shall have a Land Information Council to review the priorities, needs, policies, and expenditures of the land information office; and

WHEREAS, with the new statutory requirement for a Land Information Council, it is no longer necessary for the County to have its own Intergovernmental Land Information Advisory Board providing duplicate oversight, and,

WHEREAS, Enrolled Ordinance 155-98 designated the Department of Parks and Land Use as the County Land Information Office, but the recodification effort subsequent to the enactment of EO 155-98 did not accurately reflect the provisions of the ordinance, so the designation of the Department must be reaccomplished by repealing Section 6-26 of the Code of Ordinances.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA ORDAINS that:

SECTION 1. Two new sections of the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances shall be created to read:

Land Information Council

(a) There is established a Land Information Council consisting of eight (8) members. The following shall be appointed to the Council:

1. A member of the County Board of Supervisors.
2. The Land Information Officer.
3. The Director of the Department of Emergency Preparedness.
4. The County Surveyor.
5. The Register of Deeds.
6. The County Treasurer.

7. Representative of the Real Property Lister function.
8. A realtor or a member of the Realtors Association employed within the County.

(b) Land Information Council members shall serve four-year terms. The Land Information Officer shall serve as Chair of the Council.

County Land Information Office

(a) The Department of Parks and Land Use shall perform the functions and duties of the Waukesha County Land Information Office, as set forth in Wisconsin Statutes, section 59.72.

(b) Those duties shall consist of coordinating land information projects within the county, between the county and local governmental units, between the state and local governmental units and among local governmental units, the federal government and the private sector.

(c) The register of deeds is directed to collect and retain the fees as set forth in section 59.72, Wis. Stats, and the retainage of the fees shall be utilized to develop, implement and maintain the countywide plan for land records modernization. The county portion of the additional revenues provided by the statute shall be reserved to be used for allowable purposes only. The Department of Parks and Land Use shall, as part of the annual county budget processes, design and submit a plan for countywide land records modernization which shall include specific appropriation of these retained fees for county board approval, prior to any release or use thereof.

SECTION 2. Section 6-26 of the Waukesha County Code of Ordinances is repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective upon approval and publication.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the County of Waukesha, Wisconsin, as an addition or amendment thereto and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the numbering system contained therein.


SECTION 5. Any code section or part of a section in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.


