COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT****ORDER**


WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Supreme Court, pursuant to Article VII, Section 4 (3) of the Wisconsin Constitution, in exercising its administrative authority over the judicial system, has adopted Supreme Court Rule 70.23(3), which requires the Chief Judge of every Judicial Administrative District to design a plan for rotation of judicial assignments and file that plan with the Chief Justice or his/her designee for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Third Judicial Administrative District finds it in the best interest of judicial administration to rotate and reassign the caseloads of the following judges;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, effective August 2, 2010:

1. All criminal cases previously assigned to the Honorable Linda M. Van De Water, Circuit Court Branch 10, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable Patrick C. Haughney, Circuit Court Judge, Branch 6 in courtroom 267.
2. All civil cases previously assigned to the Michael O. Bohren, Circuit Court Judge, Branch 1, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable J. Mac Davis, Circuit Court Branch 7 in courtroom 295.
3. All criminal cases previously assigned to the Honorable J. Mac Davis, Circuit Court Judge, Branch 7, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable Michael O. Bohren, Circuit Court Branch 1 in courtroom 215.
4. All juvenile cases previously assigned to the Honorable Patrick C. Haughney, Circuit Court Judge, Branch 6, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable Paul F. Reilly, Circuit Court Branch 4 in courtroom JC124.
5. All family cases previously assigned to the Honorable Paul F. Reilly, Circuit Court Judge, Branch 4, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable Linda M. Van De Water, Circuit Court Branch 10 in courtroom 360.
6. All GN cases will be assigned to the Honorable Kathryn W. Foster, Circuit Court Branch 12.
7. All PR and IN estate and trust cases will be assigned to the Honorable Michael O. Bohren, Branch 1.
