



COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT) TRAINING

The Waukesha County Office of Emergency Management is sponsoring a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training class open to all Waukesha County citizens. This training is free and will be held at the Menomonee Falls Fire Department, W140 N7501 Lilly Rd., Menomonee Falls.

****Participants must attend both days****

This course includes basic disaster preparedness and response skills to help individuals protect themselves, their families, and their neighbors following an event when professional responders are not immediately available to help. The Los Angeles Fire Department initially developed the CERT concept to provide the citizens of Los Angeles with basic training in disaster survival and rescue skills in the event of an earthquake. The training program proved to be so beneficial that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) adopted the program and expanded the CERT materials to make them applicable to all hazards. The primary reason for CERT training is to provide employees and citizens with the skills to take care of themselves, their families, and their neighbors or co-workers following a disaster, until first responders can arrive. CERT training covers disaster preparedness, fire safety, basic disaster medical operations, light search and rescue, disaster psychology, terrorism, and team operations.

This training is open to all adults and to youth aged 13-17. Youth must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Training is not appropriate for children under the age of 13.

No more than **35 students** will be admitted into the course. Participants are accepted on a first come, first serve basis, so submit your application ASAP.
