## New Vaccination Guidelines



Parents, we want you to know  
beginning October 1, 2012

If your child is insured,  
please make an appointment with  
your primary care provider for  
vaccinations.

If your child is *Vaccines for Children*  
(VFC) eligible, you can continue to  
visit the local health department  
for vaccinations.

### Who is VFC eligible?

Children through 18 years of age who are:

- Medicaid eligible or enrolled
- Uninsured
- American Indian or Alaska Native
- Underinsured (has health insurance, but the coverage does not include all vaccines or only covers selected vaccines. Speak with your private insurance company to check if your plan covers vaccines.)
