WAUKESHA COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH has flu vaccine available for children 6 months through 18 years who are eligible for the Vaccine for Children (VFC) Program

- **Medicaid** eligible or enrolled • **Uninsured** • **American Indian or Alaska Native**
- **Insured but insurance does not cover flu vaccine**

\$8.00 for VFC children's flu vaccine
(may be waived if necessary)

Remember to Bring

- ▶ Medicaid card, cash or check
- ▶ Child's immunization record

Parent or guardian must sign on Public Health Division forms for children's immunizations
