Native seed or native plants?

Potential problems with parking lot runoff and salt.



Infiltration Basins

Engineered Soils vs sandy loam or glacial till.


Patience will be necessary due to low nutrient soils.



Retention and Detention Basins

Wetland plants will struggle in the water but flourish in the saturated soils zone (capillary fringe).

Rootstock planting and wetland seeding.



Vegetation Management and Monitoring

Mowing, selective cutting, spot spraying. Invasive woody vegetation, cattails, giant reed grass and reed canary grass management.



Selective Cutting

Excellent management tool to keep undesirable plants under control. Grazing with a weed whip.



Herbicide Application

Common Teasel (*Dipsacus fullonum*) management - Foliar application of systemic herbicides such as Transline, RoundUp or 2, 4-D



Mowing

Late spring, mid-summer and / end of year.
