



Because Google is ending its support for plug-ins in Chrome browsers, in January they are releasing a version of Chrome that will prompt users to enable Silverlight. It will produce a screen on the Waukesha County GIS as shown below.



The plug-in can be enabled by clicking in the upper right side of the address bar where the red X can be found. (It will read: “Plugins have been blocked on this page”.)

Once clicked, you will get the following prompt:



Click the button to “Always allow plug-ins on arcgisweb.waukeshacounty.gov”

Click Done

The GIS Site should then finish loading the map. This is a setting that should only have to be set once.


If you are still getting an error or Silverlight plug-in prompt, you may want to check the settings below.

Enabling the Silverlight Plug-In for Google Chrome


In Chrome browser, click the upper right Settings Icon.




Click Advanced Settings.



Under Privacy, click Content Settings



Scroll down to Plugins and click Run Automatically



It is recommended to open a new browser at this point. Again, this should be a one-time setting adjustment.
