

NOTICE: End of support for Silverlight Plug-In for Google Chrome

At release 42 of Google Chrome, the Silverlight plug-in is automatically disabled. In September of 2015, Google's Chrome browser will no longer support plug-ins, including Microsoft Silverlight. The Waukesha County GIS website will continue to work and there are three possible solutions to this problem:

1. Until September of 2015, you can continue to use Google Chrome with the Waukesha County GIS but it requires a short configuration. To enable the plug-in, do the following steps:
 - a. Type chrome://flags in the browser's address bar and hit Enter.
 - b. Search for chrome://flags/#enable-npapi on the page.
 - c. Enable it with a click on the link.
 - d. Restart the browser.
2. Use the [Firefox](#) or [Internet Explorer](#) browser instead of Chrome with the existing Silverlight viewer. These browsers continue to support plug-ins, so should work fine with the existing Silverlight viewer.
3. Use the HTML5 version of the application. Waukesha County is currently developing a browser-neutral application that requires no plug-in. An added benefit is that this application can also be used on wireless devices like iPads, iPhones as well as Android tablets and phones. The drawback is that **not all existing functionality of the Silverlight viewer is currently available in the HTML5 viewer**. Future upgrades to the HTML5 Viewer will bring 95% of these functions forward as they become available. The link for the HTML5 Viewer is:
