The Waukesha County Park System is seeking applicants for Lifeguards and Water Safety Instructors to work at the six beaches operated by Waukesha County:


- **Fox Brook Park** in Brookfield
- **Menomonee Park** (“Lannon Quarry”) in Lannon/Menomonee Falls area
- **Minooka Park** in Waukesha
- **Mukwonago Park** in Mukwonago
- **Muskego Park** in Muskego
- **Naga-Waukee Park** (on Lake Nagawicka) in Hartland/Delafield area

REQUIREMENTS FOR LIFEGUARD APPLICANTS:

- Current Lifeguard Training Certification, including CPR-Pro, AED
- Good Customer Service Skills
- Ability to use good judgement and to respond quickly
- Ability to work well as a team along with other staff
- Available to work 40 hours per week, varying shifts including weekends

REQUIREMENTS FOR WSI APPLICANTS:

- American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor (WSI) Certification
- Enjoy teaching and working with children
- Experienced preferred, but we will train if necessary
- Available to work weekday mornings from 9am to Noon



HOURS: Lifeguards: @35-40 hours per week from late May to late August
Beach Hours are 11am-7pm daily
WSI's: @10-15 hours per week June 16 to August 1, M-F 9am-Noon

PAY: Lifeguards: \$9.25 to \$10.00 per hour
WSI's: \$11.00 to \$12.00 per hour
