Tickets: \$2/Adults, \$1/children and senior citizens

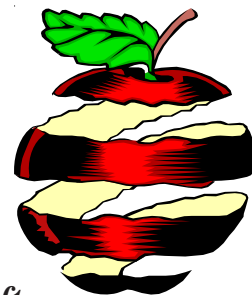
