## EAGLE

This town is under the jurisdiction of the Waukesha County Shoreland & Floodland Protection Ordinance

The Waukesha County Shoreland & Floodland Protection Ordinance is in effect in unincorporated areas and areas annexed after May 7, 1982, or areas incorporated after April 30, 1994, that are within 1,000 feet of a navigable lake or pond and/or 300 feet from any other navigable water body or up to the landward extent of its floodplain, whichever is greater.

**Map Modernization Update PENDING APPROVAL AND ADOPTION**

These maps are intended to be used as zoning maps. It may be necessary to consult other sources such as Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Floodway or Flood Insurance Rate maps, watershed studies, or topographic maps to determine regional flood insurance risk specific zones.

All shoreland determinations on these maps are subject to change based on navigability determinations by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

Wetland information is taken from the 2008 DNR/SEWRPC Wisconsin Wetland Inventory Environmental Corridor Information taken from the 2005 SEWRPC inventory with some refinements based upon recent specific survey information and 2010 aerial photo interpretation. Wetlands and Environmental Corridors were captured from aerial photography. Further field investigation may be required to determine presence or boundary of Wetlands and Environmental Corridor.
