

Public Skating Rules

- 1. SKATE AT YOUR OWN RISK!**
- 2. Skate in a counter-clockwise direction unless directed otherwise.**
- 3. Roughness, excessive speeding, cutting people off, and weaving through skaters is prohibited.**
- 4. Skating in a manner that endangers or interferes with other skaters' safety is prohibited.**
- 5. Patrons on ice surface must be wearing ice skates.**
- 6. No balls, pucks, hockey sticks, cones, chairs, etc. allowed on ice surface.**
- 7. You are not allowed to kick, throw, any objects on the ice, including gloves/mittens and snowballs.**
- 8. DO NOT walk onto bleachers, wood, metal, or cement areas while wearing ice skates.**
- 9. No food or drink allowed on the ice.**
- 10. Patrons are not allowed in the scorekeeper's box.**
- 11. Forming chains of people is prohibited.**
- 12. Carrying infants on the ice is not allowed due to the risk of injury of both the child and parent.**
- 13. Figure skating is discretionary dependent on the number of patrons participating in the session.**
- 14. No headphones allowed.**
