Waukesha, WI – The Waukesha County Land Resources program, part of the Department of Parks and Land Use, will be staffing booths at local farmers' markets in June:

In addition to fresh produce, residents can get the most up-to-date information on recycling, composting, water conservation and storm water management.

Staff will be available to answer questions about basic recycling, electronics recycling, and disposal of household hazardous waste. Patrons stopping by the booth can also learn about rain gardens and rain barrels as well as other clean water actions they can take.
