

Grass-cycling Made Easy

[Grasscycling](#) is the easiest way to feed your lawn the vital nutrients it needs to grow strong and healthy. Simply let cut grass clippings lie on the lawn where they are cut.



Grasscycling is great for you and your grass because

- it reduces the need for pesticides because the nutrients from the grass clippings nourish the soil.
- it reduces yard waste by 20 to 40% and sometimes even more!
- it reduces the need for fertilizer. Research shows that when you leave grass clippings on the lawn, you need as much as one third less fertilizer.
- it reduces the need for water.

Waukesha County does not have a yard debris disposal program for residents, though some municipalities do. Whether your municipality offers yard debris collection or not, grasscycling is the easiest way to handle grass clippings.
