Detour/ Stop and Think

- $\circ~$ Geared towards adolescents who are high-risk for substance use
- Referred to from schools, courts, and concerned families
- \circ Course covers research, phases of substance use disorder, intoxication and health problems, and works to destigmatize SUD.
- ° 8-hour course, 2-hour parent portion
- Evidence based, Prime for Life curriculum
- $^{\circ}$ After the course, most students never re-offend
- \$185/student

Resist the Influence

- 7-79th grade health classes (as requested)
 To prevent or delay initiation of substance
 use Increase self-efficacy to deal with
 stressors/ pressures to refuse substances
 Grant based
 5.45-minute courses
 Peer influence
 Nicotine
 Alcohol
