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## What is ARPA?

*American Rescue Plan Act*

Federal funding with **few** restrictions that enhance impact and address health disparities

Waukesha County can award **\$300,000**

Funding to be awarded to each health priority

Competitive selection process

Diverse Scoring Panel

People 60+ in Waukesha County will be safe from falls

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### Data Indicators

- ↓ Decrease number of emergency department visits due to falls.
- ↓ Decrease number of hospital admissions due to falls.
- ↓ Decrease number of Waukesha County 911 calls due to falls.

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## Healthy Aging

All People in Waukesha County will have social connections

Conduct an Environmental Scan	Centralize Resources	Intergenerational Skill Sharing	Volunteer Engagement Campaign
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### Data Indicators

- ↓ Decrease number of adults reporting feeling loneliness and isolation from those around them.
- ↓ Decrease percentage of those reporting "poor mental health days."

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## Mental Health

All Adolescents Between the Ages of 12-18 in Waukesha County will have improved access to mental health services and increased knowledge of mental health resources

Expand Ending the Silence	Mental Health Awareness Days	School Mental Health Worker	Mental Health Hotlines	Data and Evaluation
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### Data Indicators

- ↓ Decrease percent of students who self-report depression in Waukesha County
- ↑ Increase number of youth mental or behavioral health visits
- ↑ Increase percent of visits by anxiety and depression

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## Substance Use

People who Use or are in Recovery for Opioid Use in Waukesha County will have access to life saving interventions

Promote Harm Reduction	Reduce Stigma	Educate on Benefits of Certified Peer Specialists	Employ People in Long-Term Recovery as Certified Peer Specialists
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### Data Indicators

- ↓ Decrease number of Opioid Related Deaths for Waukesha County Residents 18-44 Years Old
- ↑ Increase number of People Receiving Certified Peer Specialist (CPS) substance use support in Waukesha County

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## Substance Use

Waukesha County Residents who Use Opioids Will Have Access to Stable Housing

Asset Map	Develop Advocacy Plan	Substance Use Housing Navigator Model
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## Data Indicators

- ↑ Increase percent of people in substance use treatment who have a stable place to live
- ↓ Decrease percent of people who use substances and are experiencing homelessness

- Must serve Waukesha County residents
- Must align with CHIP action teams

- March 21 '24: Virtual Information Session
- April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024: Applications Due
- April 5 '24: T.A. Session
- May '24: Applications scored
- June '24: Contracts Awarded
- June '24 - June '25: Begin projects and reporting

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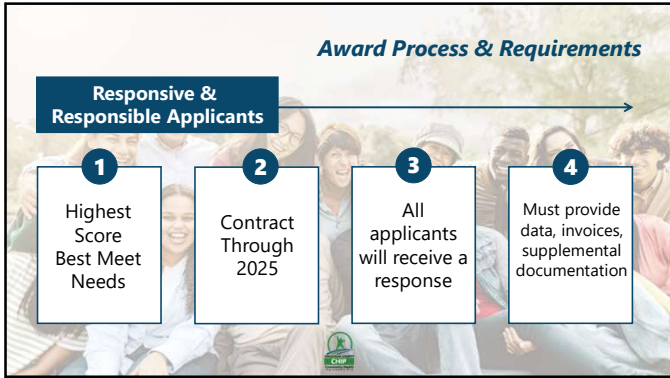
