Mr. James Kebisek, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 9:03 A.M.

REVIEW MINUTES OF JULY 21, 2016

The minutes of the July 21, 2016 meeting were reviewed. There were no corrections to the minutes.

Mr. Johannes mentioned the veteran that was assisted in July 2016 was extremely grateful for the assistance provided to him.

Mr. Holmes made a motion to accept the minutes. Mr. Craney seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

BUDGET

Mr. Johannes informed the Commission there are no changes to the budget. Approximately \$6,000 in donations from several sources were accepted by our office over the Christmas Holidays. These donations were in addition to our annual budgeted amount. The donations will be put into an account that will not revert back to the County's General Fund at the end of the year.

Mr. Johannes stated our office utilizes resources in the community, such as La Casa to provide budget counseling services and a neutral third-party review of a veteran's financial situation, prior to using the resources in our budget / donated resources.
