**Discuss and Consider Ordinance 178-O-079 Create One Regular Full-Time Special Prosecutor, One Regular Full-Time Senior Administrative Specialist, And One Regular Full-Time Victim Witness Specialist In The District Attorney's Office With A Sunset Provision Of December 31, 2024**

Opper presented that the 2024 District Attorney County General Fund Budget was amended to appropriate unallocated American Rescue Plan Act funds to support additional staff coverage for the sixth criminal court and victim/witness services. This ordinance creates one regular full-time Special Prosecutor, one regular full-time Senior Administrative Specialist, and one regular full-time Victim Witness Specialist in the District Attorney's Office with a sunset provision of December 31, 2024.
