MINUTES OF October 16, 2018


The Waukesha County Sheriff's Grievance Committee was called to order on October 16, 2018 at 3:00 p.m., by Chairman Raasch In the Matter of Charges Filed Against Deputy Bryan M. Skaar. Present were committee members Steliga, Henschel, Del la Mora, Spangler and Raasch. Also present was representative of the Sheriff's Department, Deputy Inspector James Gumm. Also present was Deputy Bryan M. Skaar and his Attorney Christopher MacGillis and Brent Hart of the WPPA.

Motion was then made and seconded and was unanimously approved that the Committee go into closed session pursuant to Section 59.26(8)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Presentation was made by the representative of the Sheriff's Department, Deputy Inspector Gumm and thereafter statements of Deputy Bryan M. Skaar and Attorney MacGillis on his behalf were made stipulating to the charges but not to the proposed three (3) day suspension sanction requested by the Sheriff pursuant to Deputy Skaar's violation of Sec. 5.01 Use of Department Vehicle and 1.09 Unsatisfactory Performance.

Following the testimony, closing statements and questions by the Committee, it reviewed the testimony responses and record in deliberation, taking into consideration §59.26(b)5m of the Wisconsin Statutes, and rendered its decision, a copy of which is attached hereto.
