- Southeast Wisconsin Homeland Security Partnership hosting a tabletop exercise at Molson Coors on October 12, 2022. Information can be found in OEM Report.
- Tour of Nature's Path facility (off site plan) Friday with Sussex FD to do site tour at 10am, Batzko expressed interest in attendance.
- Computer Hazmat and Equipment Grant Award letter received, \$7,517 awarded, grant closeout in December.
- SE Region asked to host regional hazmat exercise/commodity flow study, Walworth Co. administrator of grants and host activities, Waukesha Co. signed to participate (Signed by Bowen) when things come to be Goodchild will reach out.
- Taylor Williams recently joined our office as a Deputy Emergency Management Coordinator.
- Wisconsin Emergency Management changed performance period for grants, cycle now will align with 12-month calendar year, rest of offsite plans will be at next meeting.
- Batzko questioned on future exercises or trainings focusing on mass casualties. Goodchild explained plan to conduct an active assailant exercise in 2023 for the County.
