WHEREAS, Section 349.13 of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that local authorities may regulate the parking, standing and stopping of vehicles along such highways, and

WHEREAS Waukesha County contracted to have an independent study of parking along CTH P near the Bark River to address safety concerns; and

WHEREAS this independent report revealed existing conditions along County Highway P that are inadequate for off road parking and maintaining safe sight distances for the residents with access to CTH P.


THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF WAUKESHA DOES ORDAIN that the following parking regulation shall be in effect upon the placement of proper signs:

The east side of CTH P from the centerline of Genesee Lake Road northerly to the centerline of Elm Street and the west side of CTH P from the centerline of Genesee Lake Road northerly a point 375 feet North of the centerline of Genesee Lake Road and 635 feet South of Elm Street northerly to a point 310 feet South of Elm Street in the Village of Summit — No Parking At Any Time.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance rescinds all other previous parking regulations for the above-described portion of the County Trunk Highway System.


