
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Executive Order #100, issued by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, dated December 22, 2020, that on Tuesday, April 6, 2021, a Special Election will be held in the several wards and election districts of the Thirteenth Senate District in the State of Wisconsin, consisting of State Assembly Districts 37, 38, and 39, and those parts of Columbia, Dane, Dodge, Jefferson, Washington, and Waukesha counties as described in Chapter 4 of the Wisconsin Statutes, at which the following officer is to be elected:

A STATE SENATOR FOR THE THIRTEENTH DISTRICT

to fill the vacancy, caused by the resignation of Scott Fitzgerald, for the term which expires on January 2, 2023.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the earliest date for circulating nomination papers is today, Thursday, December 22, 2020, and the deadline for filing nomination papers for the Special Election will be 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 8, 2021, in the office of the Wisconsin Elections Commission, 212 East Washington Avenue, Third Floor, Madison, Wisconsin. The Special Primary, if necessary, will be held on Tuesday, February 16, 2021. A description of the boundaries of the 13th State Senate District, as created in 2011 Act 43, is set out in 2017-2018 Wisconsin Statutes Section 4.009 (13) and 4.37, 4.38, and 4.39.
