

<b>Waukesha Community Service Options</b>	
<b>Description</b>	<p>The Community Service Options (CSO) Program provides support and monitoring to adult offenders who are court-referred at sentencing to community services. Staff arrange for Huber inmates to perform community service at local nonprofits and subsequently receive time off their sentence, and provide assistance and monitoring of individual court ordered community service for adult Probation/Parole clients and those ordered directly from court in lieu of fines. The overall goal is for offenders to “give back” to the community and to provide over 100 community organizations and nonprofits with valuable volunteer service.</p> <p><b>In 2017, the program served a total of 610 adult offenders. Participants completed over 16,000 total hours of community service at local non-profits in Waukesha County, saving nearly 1,000 jail days.</b></p>
