- No Set Amount of Funding per Strategic Health Priority
- 18-Month Contract
- Quarterly Payments Based on Budget
- Application Sections Include; Program Design, Impact on Social Determinants of Health, Organizational Experience, Capacity, & Sustainability, Budget, and Logic Model

ARPA funding can pay for ...

- Salaries and fringe benefits
- Training
- Start-up costs
- Existing program expansion
- Develop new evidence-based programming
- Purchase technology or equipment
- Improve data tracking and reporting
- Gather data

Awards will be made to responsive and responsible applicant(s):


- That attain the highest scored application(s)
- That best meet the needs identified by the CHIP process
- That align with the indicators and strategies of the action teams

Applications are evaluated by a diverse committee

All applicants will be notified in writing of the award intentions Agencies awarded contracts will complete the following:

- Quarterly goals and outcomes
- Monthly invoices
- Supplemental invoice documentation (2-4 awarded applicants)
