
Walk-in service during business hours

What Are Sexually Transmitted Diseases

Sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) are diseases that can be passed from one person to another during all types of sexual contact. Examples of STDs include chlamydia, gonorrhea, herpes, HIV, HPV, syphilis, pubic lice and genital warts. Symptoms of STDs may include pain while urinating, burning, itching, sores, discharge, bumps or blisters in genital area. However, a person may be infected with an STD and not have symptoms.

Who Can Attend the Comprehensive STD/HIV Clinic

The Comprehensive STD/HIV Clinic is available to anyone seeking confidential counseling, examination and testing for STDs. The clinic is available by appointment only, and the fee is \$40; however, no one is turned away for inability to pay. Please call the Public Health Division at (262) 896-8450 to schedule an appointment.

The Waukesha County Public Health Division Comprehensive STD/HIV Clinic, mentioned on the left, provides confidential counseling, examination and testing for the following:

- Syphilis – Chlamydia**
