

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing will be held Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, **the hearings will be conducted virtually via the Microsoft Teams application** (an Internet connection and a web browser are required). Phone access will also be available. The hearings are open to the public and individuals are invited to participate via Microsoft Teams or via telephone.

Refer to the Phantom Lake District Territory Attachment Public Hearing Link and Documents heading located in the middle portion of the page under News and Events. Public hearing documents, Microsoft Teams link and the meeting telephone number will be posted no later than five days prior to the hearing date.

On January 13, 2021, a petition was filed with Waukesha County for the attachment of territory to the Phantom Lakes Management District (“District”) pursuant to Chapter 33 of Wisconsin Statutes.

The territory of the proposed attachment includes Lot 1 of Certified Survey Map 11953 in the Village of Mukwonago recorded with the Waukesha County Register of Deeds on July 29, 2020 as document # 443148 (Tax Key No. MUKV2009965003).

Pursuant to sec. 33.26, Wisconsin Statutes, at the hearing, all interested persons may offer objections, criticisms, or suggestions as to the necessity of the proposed District territory attachment as outlined and question whether their property will be benefited by being in the District. Any person wishing to object to the attachment of territory to the Phantom Lakes Management District may, before the date set for the hearing, file their objection in writing and mailed to the attention of Alan Barrows, Waukesha County Administration Center, 515 W. Moreland Blvd., Room AC260, Waukesha, Wisconsin, 53188 or by email to: cod@waukeshacounty.gov. Mailed and emailed comments must be received by Friday, February 5, 2021.

The public hearing will be facilitated by the Waukesha County Phantom Lakes District Ad-hoc Committee on behalf of the Waukesha County Land Use, Parks and Environment (LUPE) Committee. A quorum of LUPE may be present at the hearing, but no action will be taken.
