

COMMON ISSUES DURING PLAN REVIEW:

- Phone calls + Concept mtg + Checklists + Development
- Handbook: Helps reduce missing SW information.
- Waukesha County Airport/Crites Field: located within City of Waukesha.
 - FAA Advisory Circular 150 5200 33B: Confirm applicability of proposed wet pond design to FAA requirements for separation of wet ponds within 5 miles of airport.
 - Coordinate with Waukesha County Airport Manager or FAA staff.
- Including tailwater effect in stormwater design.

Recording SW Maintenance Agreements

Brookfield:

Record Agreements in two parts - prior to construction beginning & after as-built data is available.

Waukesha:

Approved by BPW/Council and provide recorded MA prior to issuance of building permit or starting work.

SWM Agreements: Special Requirements

- Owner agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents and employees against any and all
 actions, damages, judgments, costs, or fees of any kind whatsoever arising out of any act, error, or omission of the
 Owner, its agents, or employees relating to this agreement.
- Copies of all inspection reports must be submitted to the City of Brookfield every other year, beginning on the
 first even year after the signing of the Agreement (e.g. Agreement signed in 2023, first report is due in 2024, then
 2026, and so on). Inspection reports must be sent by January 3 to: ATTN: Stormwater Engineer, City of
 Brookfield Engineering, 2000 N. Calhoun Road, Brookfield, WI 53005.

SWM Agreements: Older Developments

DEVELOPER'S AGREEMENT

SWM Agreements: Older Developments

Waukesha:

- Having knowledge of locations where MA's are needed and a GIS or listing of current agreements for quick reference is helpful.
- When modifications to sites come to PC for approval, then the MA can be added as a condition.
- Don't issue building permit until SW Agreement is recorded

SWM Agreements: Problem Areas in Enforcement & Solutions

- Owner/HOA hasn't budgeted for regular or major maintenance activities:
 - 1. Ensure Owner(s) are aware of responsibilities and costs upfront.
 - 2. Engineer/Designer should specify SW BMPs the fit with the development's likely inspection and maintenance abilities.
 - 3. Annual reminders of maintenance duties.
- Residents/HOA's lacking understanding of what to do and when to do it.
 - 1. Meet with HOA.
 - 2. Provide resources.

SWM Agreements: Problem Areas in Enforcement & Solutions

- ❖ SW BMP's & Agreements;
 - 1. Lack of understanding what a Qualified Professional is.
 - 2. Not submitting documentation of annual inspections.
 - 3. Documentation inaccurate.



SWM Agreements: Problem Areas in Enforcement & Solutions

- Continued education (e.g. Waukesha SW Workshop)
- Atypical Enforcement Options:
 - 1. Site meetings.
 - 2. Verbal & written reminders/warnings.
 - 3. Conditions on project approvals.
