\*Bring your own wire, tape, string and tools (pliers, scissors, etc.)  
to attach your scarecrow to the stakes.\*

Entries not picked up by Mon., Oct. 28 will be discarded.

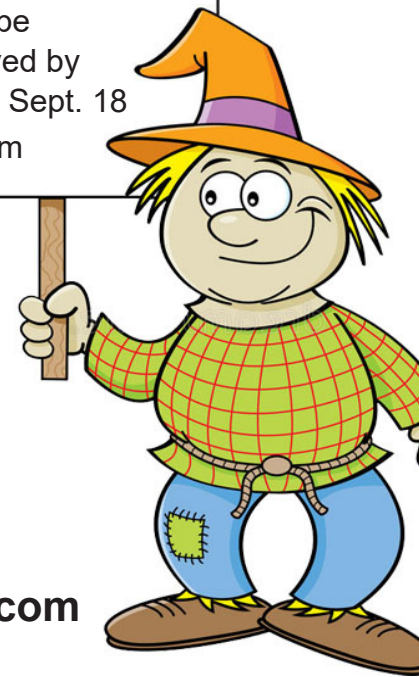

(Hwy. 18) to County Road DT, turn right, and  
then first left onto Madison St. (Our entrance  
is on the right.)
