Who Can Participate?

Active and inactive farms, businesses, government, schools, co-ops, golf courses, right-of-way applicators, aerial applicators, landscape companies, retail stores, real estate management companies and others in Waukesha County.

Farms and Farm Properties

Any operating farm or inactive farm is eligible for free disposal for up to 500 pounds of farm chemicals. Farmers may be required to pay for amounts over 500 pounds, depending on grant budget.

Businesses and Institutions

DATCP offers a 50% disposal subsidy for waste pesticides only. Businesses must pay the remaining balance. A price quote will be provided based on the pre-registration inventory.



Your business or organization is fully liable if an employee or customer is harmed by waste chemicals or if waste chemicals leak into the environment.

Types of Chemicals Accepted:

Virtually all damaged or unwanted chemicals including:

Pesticides: herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, rodenticides including silvex, atrazine, 2,4-D, captan, malathion, DDT, parathion, chlordane, lindane, 2,4,5-T

Chemicals: lead arsenate, wood preservatives, creosote, penta, lead and oil paint, solvents, wood finishes, acids, oxidizers, pool chemicals and sanitizers, engine degreasers, parts cleaners, acid washes.

Unacceptable Materials:

- Explosives, including detonators and blasting caps
- Radioactives, including smoke alarms
- Infectious and biological wastes
- Freon 11 and 12
- Propane tanks and cylinders
- Waste oil
- Latex paint

How to Participate

- 1) Pre-register (**online** or via phone)
- 2) Estimate types and quantities of hazardous materials for disposal. Email completed form to recycling@waukeshacounty.gov
- 3) Receive confirmation of drop off location and date. Review proper handling precautions before transporting materials. Bring in materials.
