

TRAFFIC SWITCH UPDATE

As part of Waukesha County's North Avenue (County M) reconstruction project, the upcoming traffic switch, is scheduled for the next phase of the project.

Beginning Monday, September 14, 2020:


- Eastbound traffic on North Avenue from Calhoun Road to Marilyn Drive, is scheduled to be shifted to the south, onto the newly paved outside lane, while crews begin work to reconstruct the median and inside lanes.
- Westbound traffic on North Avenue at 166th Street, is scheduled to be shifted to the south onto the newly paved eastbound lane, while crews work to reconstruct the westbound lanes.

One lane of traffic on North Avenue will be maintained in each direction.

- Brook Springs and Pilgrim Square drive intersections, at North Avenue, are scheduled to be reconstructed for approximately three weeks.
- 166th Street and Hillsdale Drive East intersections, at North Avenue, will be right-in and right-out only.

Alternate Route:

- Motorists traveling to and from the above-mentioned side streets, are encouraged to use Pilgrim Road, Fieldstone, and Kevenauer drives to get around closures.



Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
