PROJECT BRIEF

NORTH AVENUE TO OPEN TO TWO LANES IN EACH DIRECTION

Waukesha County, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), has completed majority of work scheduled to take place in 2021 on the North Avenue (County M) reconstruction project from Calhoun Road to 124th Street.

Thursday, December 16, 2021:

- Traffic on North Avenue is scheduled to reopen to two lanes in each direction

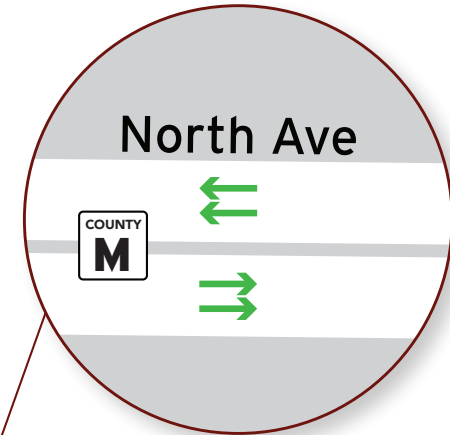
The following work was completed in two phases:

- Reconstruction of three miles of North Avenue (County M) from a two-lane roadway into a four-lane divided highway
- New pavement structure, curb and gutter, curb and gutter, and additional sidewalk
- Storm sewer improvements, including three retention ponds
- Upgraded intersections along the corridor to improve safety standards
- Replacement and installation of existing and new traffic signals at Calhoun, Pilgrim, and Lilly roads, and 124th Street
- Bridge constructed over the Underwood Creek

Work Scheduled to be Completed in Spring 2022:

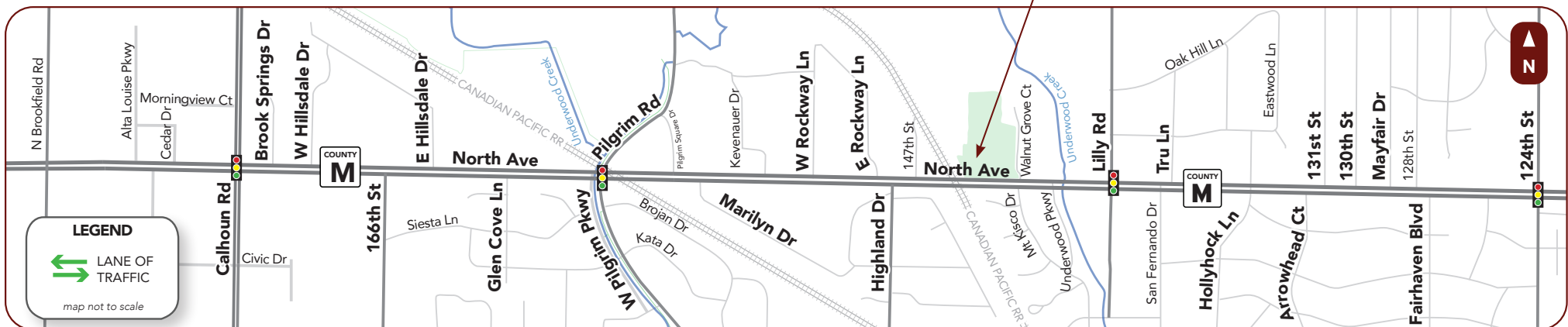
- Minor restoration work
- Concrete curb and gutter work (as necessary)
- Retaining wall staining

* Motorists can expect intermittent lanes closures in order to complete the work listed above
