NORTH AVENUE (COUNTY M) RECONSTRUCTION TO RESUME

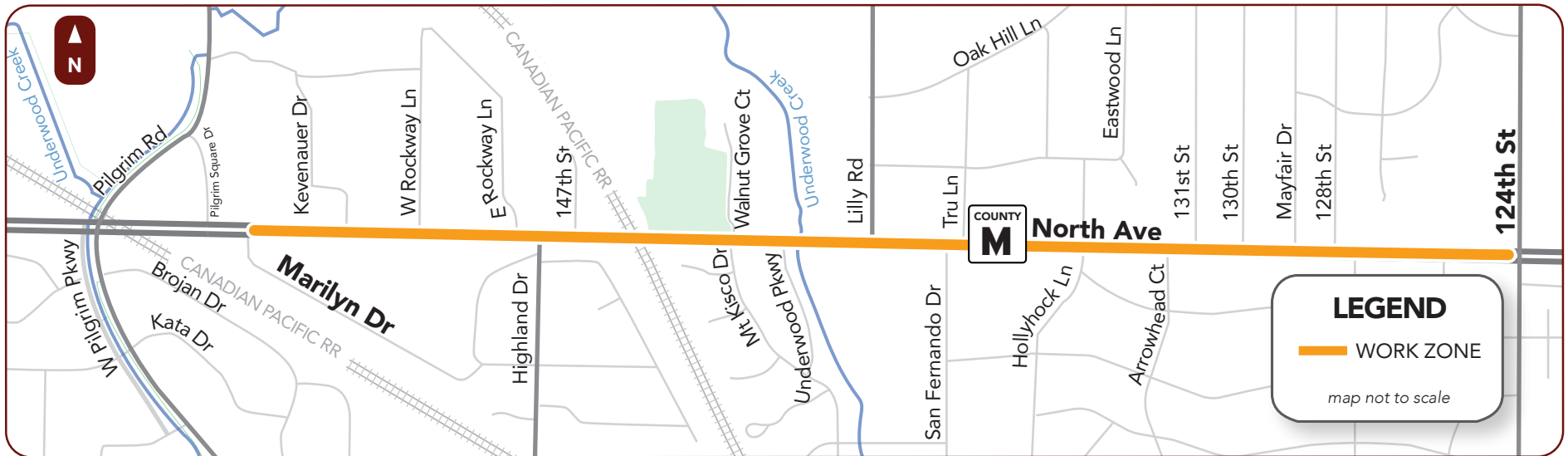
Waukesha County, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), is scheduled to resume reconstruction of North Avenue (County M), with scheduled completion of winter 2021.

Work scheduled to be completed in 2021:

- Reconstruct North Avenue, from Marilyn Drive to 124th Street, to a four-lane divided highway
- Installation of storm sewer, and curb and gutter
- Sidewalk and retaining walls throughout the project
- Intersections within the project limits will be reconstructed to improve standards and safety
- Construct pond at the northwest corner of North Avenue and Hollyhock Lane
- Reconstructing the bridge over Underwood Creek located west of Lilly Road
- Upgrade intersection on North Avenue at Lilly Road
- One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction during construction

*Travelers should be aware that the speed limit has been reduced to 25 mph and should account for additional travel time. Please obey traffic control signs and pavement markings, and drive safely throughout the work zone.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
