TRAFFIC SWITCH & LILLY ROAD CLOSURE

As part of Waukesha County's North Avenue (County M) reconstruction project between Marilyn Drive and 124th Street, the following work is scheduled for the next phase of this project.

Beginning Wednesday, May 26:

- Lilly Road north of North Avenue is scheduled to close long-term for approximately two months, while crews work to reconstruct the intersection
- Eastbound traffic on North Avenue, between Marilyn Drive and East Rockway Lane, and between Tru Lane and 124th Street, is scheduled to be shifted to the north onto the existing westbound lanes, while crews reconstruct the eastbound lanes
- Westbound traffic on North Avenue, between East Rockway Lane and Tru Lane is scheduled to be shifted to the south onto the existing eastbound lanes, while crews reconstruct the westbound lanes

One lane of traffic on North Avenue will be maintained in each direction.

During this work, the following intersections are scheduled to be reconstructed at North Avenue:

- East Rockway, Tru, and Hollyhock lanes, Arrowhead Court, Fairhaven Boulevard, and Cloverhill Road

Hollyhock Lane and Arrowhead Court will not be closed concurrently.

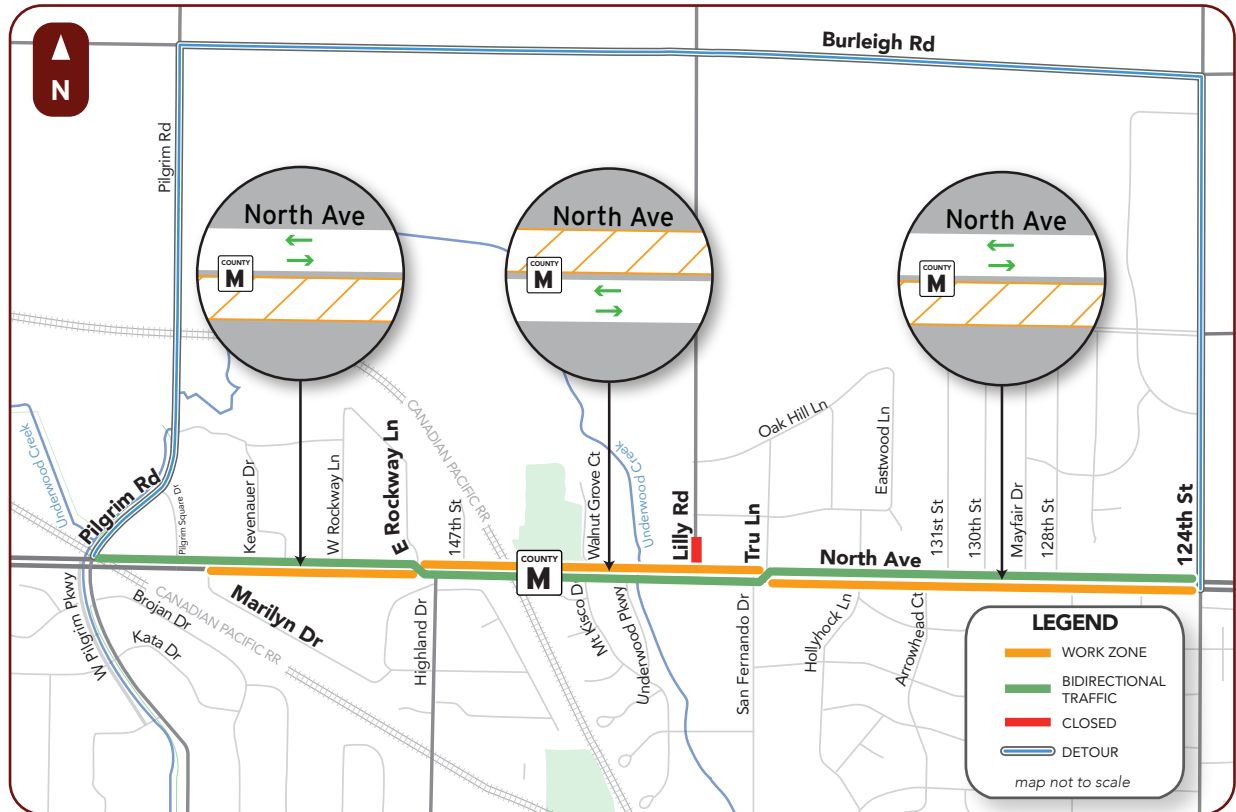
Fairhaven Boulevard will not be closed concurrently with Hollyhock Lane or Arrowhead Court.

Detour Route:

→ Motorists are encouraged to use Pilgrim and Burleigh roads, and 124th Street to get around the closure.

Access to businesses and residents will be maintained.
