NORTH AVENUE HAS REOPENED TO TRAFFIC

Waukesha County's reconstruction project has completed the majority of the work on North Avenue (County M) for this phase of the project.

Thursday, December 10, 2020:

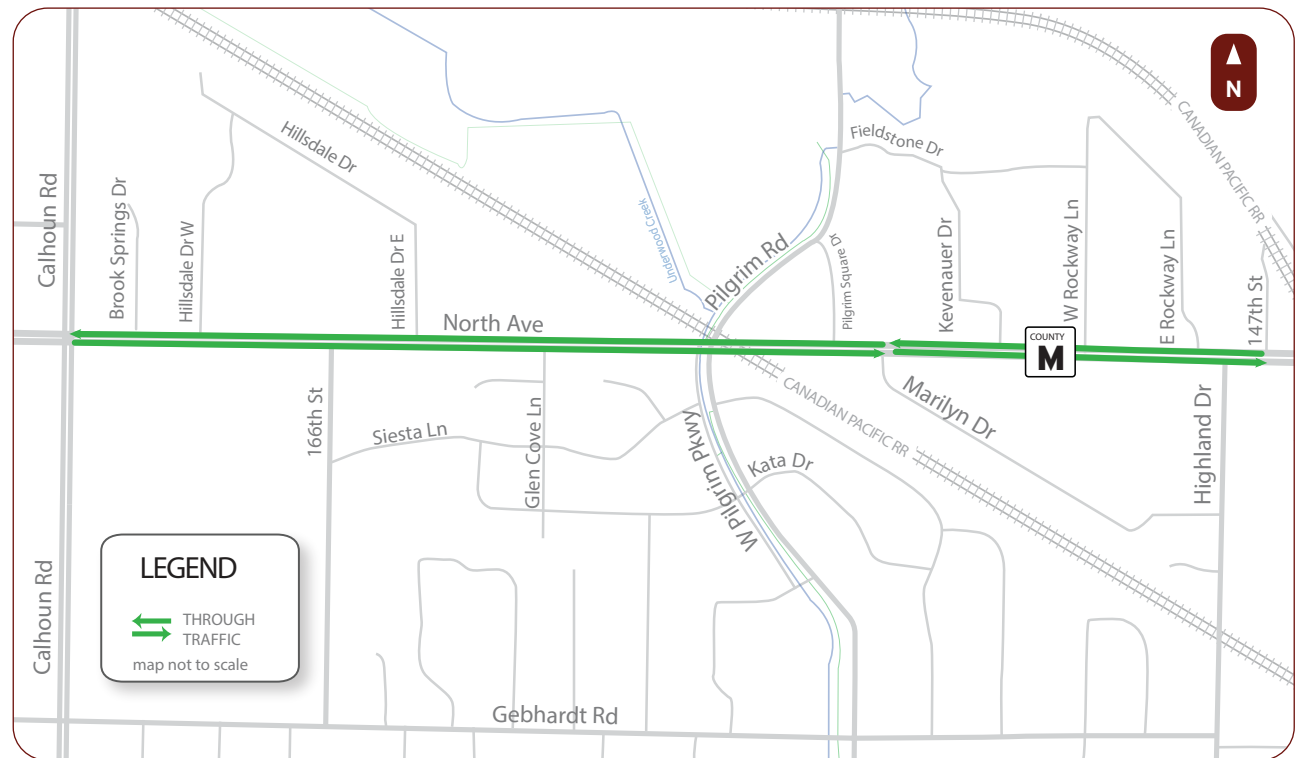
- North Avenue, between Calhoun Road and Marilyn Drive, has reopened to all lanes.

Work completed in 2020:

- Reconstruction of North Avenue from a two-lane to a four-lane divided highway.
- New pavement structure, curb and gutter, additional sidewalk, and storm sewer improvements.
- Intersections within these limits, were upgraded to improve standards and safety.
- Minor restoration and electrical work related to permanent signals and lighting, will continue through December.

Travelers should be aware of the new traffic pattern, use only designated left-turn locations, obey traffic control signs and pavement markings, and drive safely throughout the work zone.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
