PROJECT BRIEF

December 13, 2021

NORTH AVENUE TO OPEN TO TWO LANES IN EACH DIRECTION

Waukesha County, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), has completed majority of work scheduled to take place in 2021 on the North Avenue (County M) reconstruction project from Calhoun Road to 124th Street.

Thursday, December 16, 2021:

- Traffic on North Avenue is scheduled to reopen to two lanes in each direction

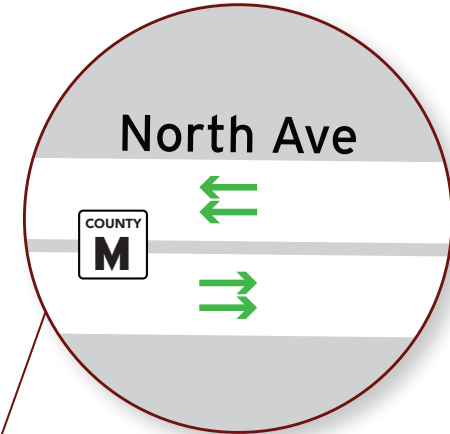
The following work was completed in two phases:

- Reconstruction of three miles of North Avenue (County M) from a two-lane roadway into a four-lane divided highway
- New pavement structure, curb and gutter, curb and gutter, and additional sidewalk
- Storm sewer improvements, including three retention ponds
- Upgraded intersections along the corridor to improve safety standards
- Replacement and installation of existing and new traffic signals at Calhoun, Pilgrim, and Lilly roads, and 124th Street
- Bridge constructed over the Underwood Creek

Work Scheduled to be Completed in Spring 2022:

- Minor restoration work
- Concrete curb and gutter work (as necessary)
- Retaining wall staining

* Motorists can expect intermittent lanes closures in order to complete the work listed above

NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN ON NORTH AVENUE

As part of Waukesha County's North Avenue (County M) reconstruction project, the following work is scheduled for the next phase of this project.

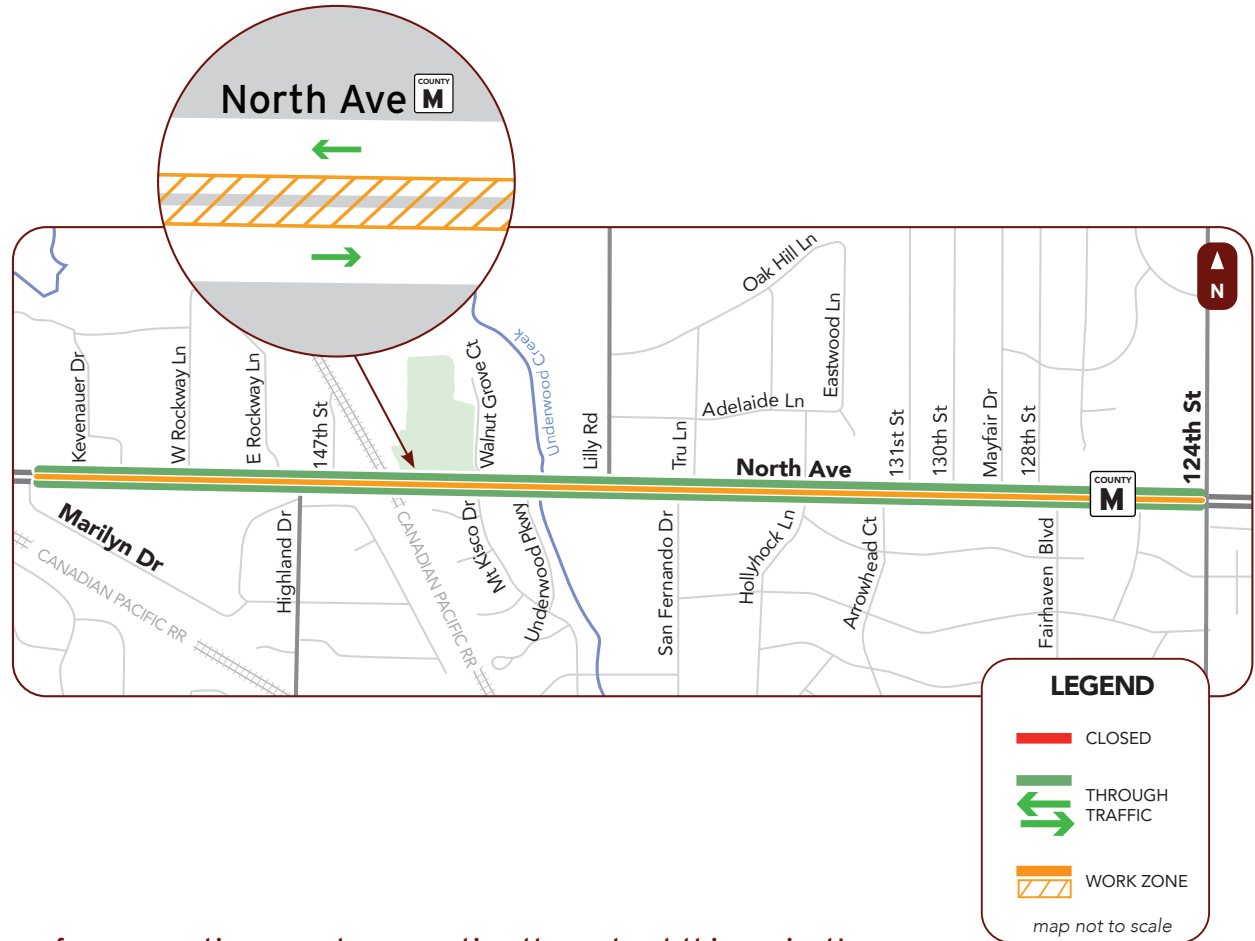
Beginning, Monday November 22:

- Eastbound and westbound traffic on North Avenue, between Marilyn Drive and 124th Street, is scheduled to be shifted to their respective sides of the roadway, on to the newly paved outside lanes, while crews work to construct the median
- Access at East Rockway Lane, will be maintained with right-in and right-out movements

One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.

PROJECT UPDATE

As part of Waukesha County's North Avenue reconstruction project, the upcoming traffic switch is scheduled for the next phase of the project.

Monday, June 8, 2020:

- North Avenue, between Calhoun Road and Marilyn Drive, are scheduled to be shifted to the north onto the temporary widening, while crews work to reconstruct the eastbound lanes. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction.

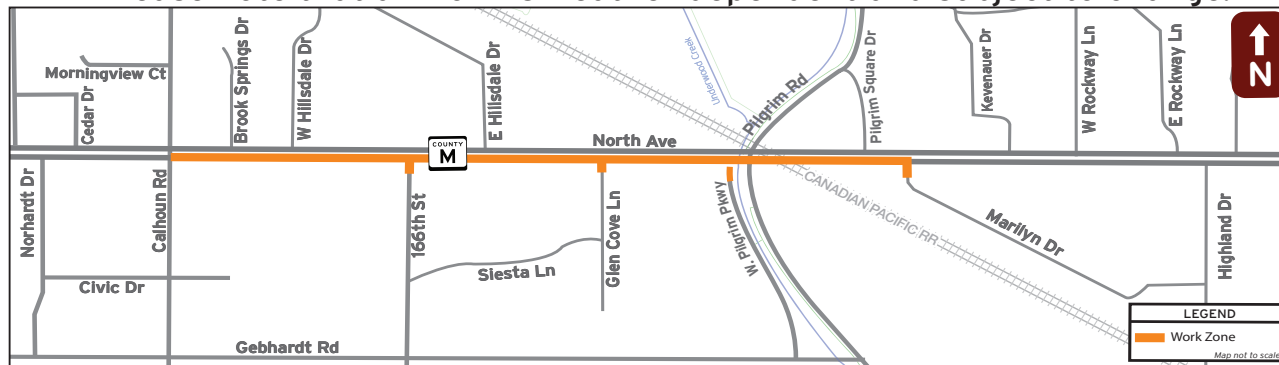
During this phase, the following intersections are scheduled to be reconstructed at North Avenue:

- 166th Street, Glen Cove Lane, W. Pilgrim Parkway and Marilyn Drive.
- 166th Street and Glen Cove Lane intersections will not be closed concurrently.

Alternate Route:

- Motorists traveling to and from the above mentioned side streets are encouraged to use 166th Street, Highland Drive, Glen Cove, and Siesta lanes to get around the closures.

As part of Waukesha County's North Avenue (County M) reconstruction project, the upcoming storm sewer and water main work is scheduled for the next phase of the project.

Sunday, May 31, 2020:

- Calhoun Road, between North Avenue and Morningview Court, is scheduled to close to traffic from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Monday, June 1, 2020:

- Calhoun Road, between North Avenue and Civic Drive, is scheduled to close to traffic from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Tuesday, June 2, 2020:

- North Avenue, between Calhoun Road and Cedar Drive, is scheduled to close to traffic from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Wednesday, June 3, 2020:

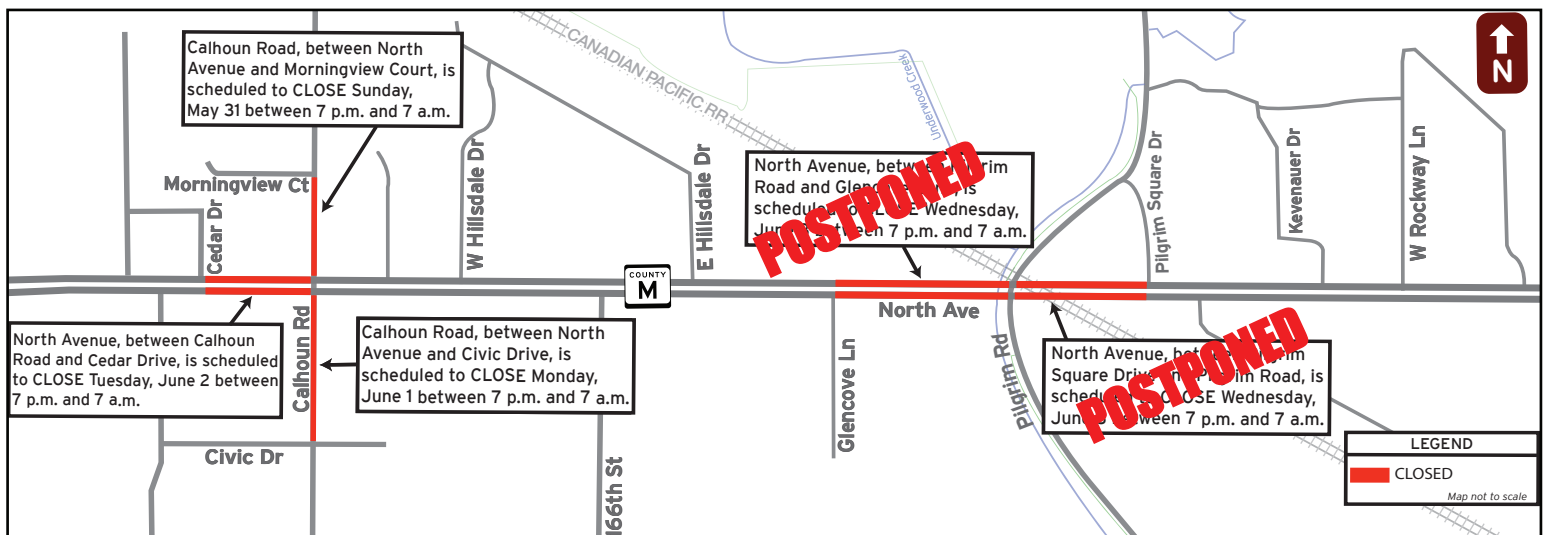
- North Avenue, between Pilgrim Road and Glencove Lane, is scheduled to close to traffic from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- North Avenue, between Pilgrim Square Drive and Pilgrim Road, is scheduled to close to traffic from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Alternate Route:

- ➔ Motorists are encouraged to use Capitol Drive, Burleigh Road and Brookfield Road to get around the closures.

NORTH AVENUE (COUNTY M) WORK TO BEGIN

As part of The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), in conjunction with Waukesha County, reconstruction of North Avenue (County M) from Calhoun Road to 124th Street, is scheduled to begin Monday May 18, with a scheduled completion late fall 2021.

The following work is scheduled for the first phase of the project:

Beginning Monday, May 18, 2020:

- North Avenue eastbound and westbound lanes between Calhoun Road and Kevenauer Drive will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction.
- Calhoun Road and Pilgrim Parkway will be reduced to one lane in each direction at the intersection of North Avenue while crews work to remove the median.
- Temporary traffic signals are scheduled to be installed at the Calhoun Road intersection.

All intersections at North Avenue will remain open during this stage of the project.

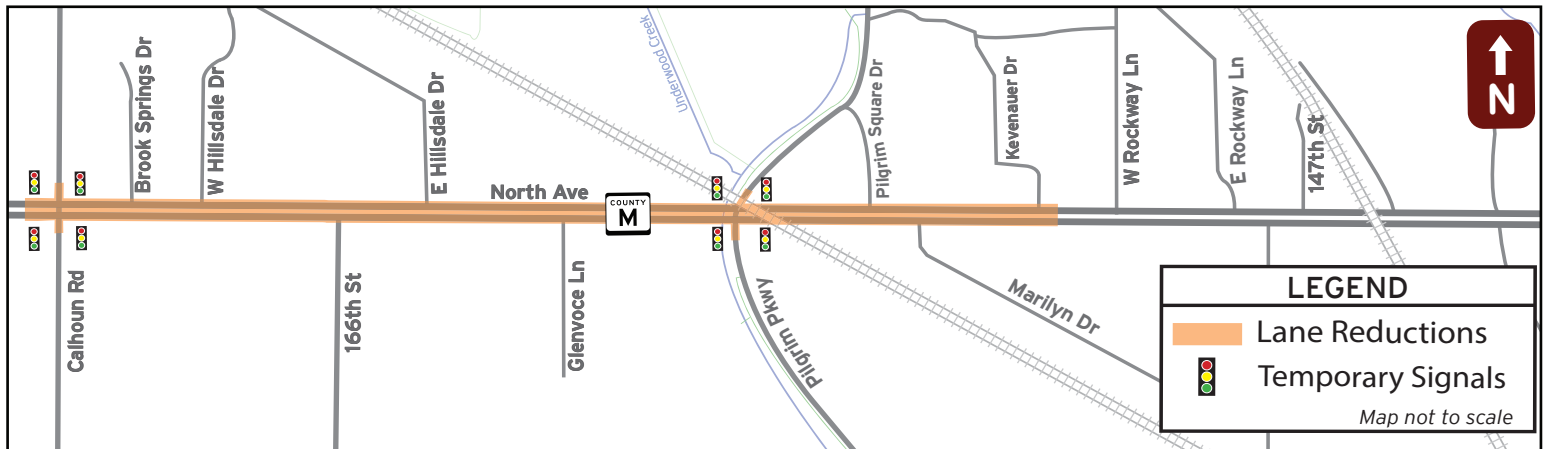
Beginning Tuesday, May 26, 2020:

- Temporary traffic signals are scheduled to be installed at the Pilgrim Parkway intersection.
- Storm sewer work at the intersection of North Avenue and Pilgrim Parkway.
- Crews will begin to remove the existing pavement on the northern side of North Avenue to build the temporary widening.
- Paving the temporary roadway widening on North Avenue.

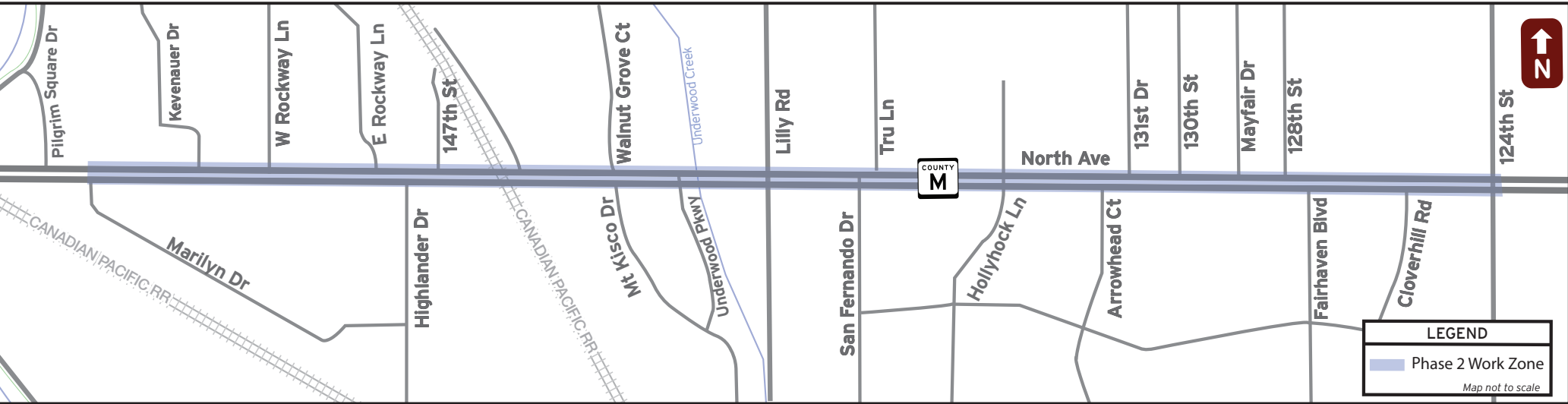

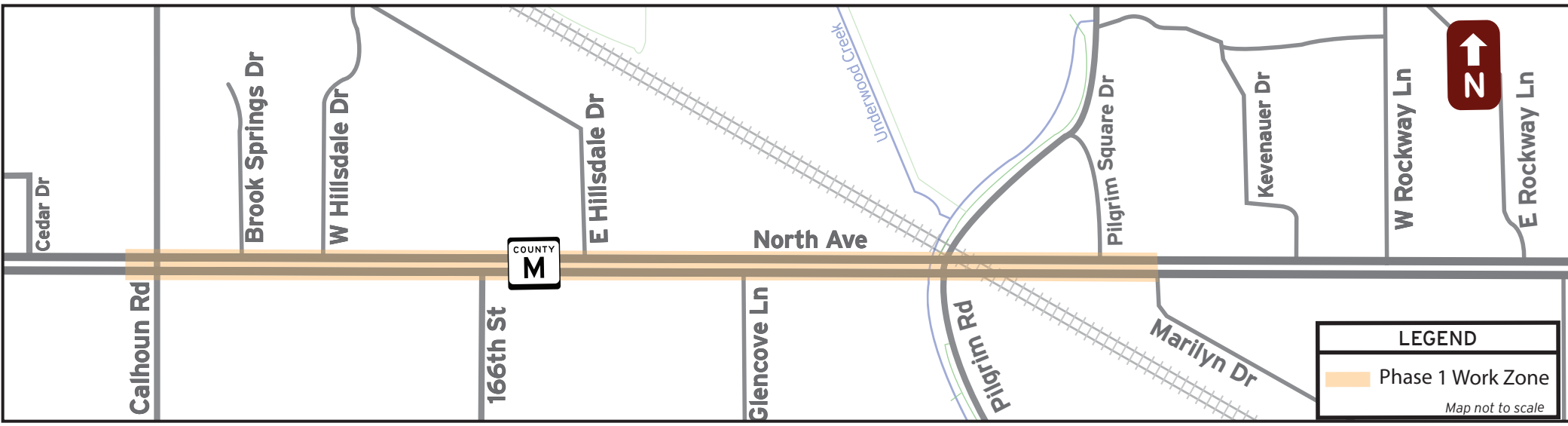

NORTH AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION FROM CALHOUN ROAD TO 124TH STREET

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), in conjunction with Waukesha County, is scheduled to begin the 3-mile reconstruction of North Avenue (County M) from Calhoun Road to 124th Street, beginning early to mid-May 2020 with a scheduled completion of winter 2021.

The project will include the following:

- Reconstruct North Avenue from a two-lane to a four-lane divided highway from Calhoun Road to 124th Street.
- Intersections within the North Avenue project limits will be upgraded to improve standards and to improve safety.
- New pavement structure, curb and gutter, additional sidewalk, and storm water improvements.
- All signalized intersections will be upgraded with the latest equipment along with increased vehicle capacity.
- Replacement of the bridge structure over Underwood Creek located west of Lilly Road.

The project will be completed in two phases.

Phase 1:

- Reconstruct North Avenue between Calhoun Road to Marilyn Drive in 2020.

Phase 2:

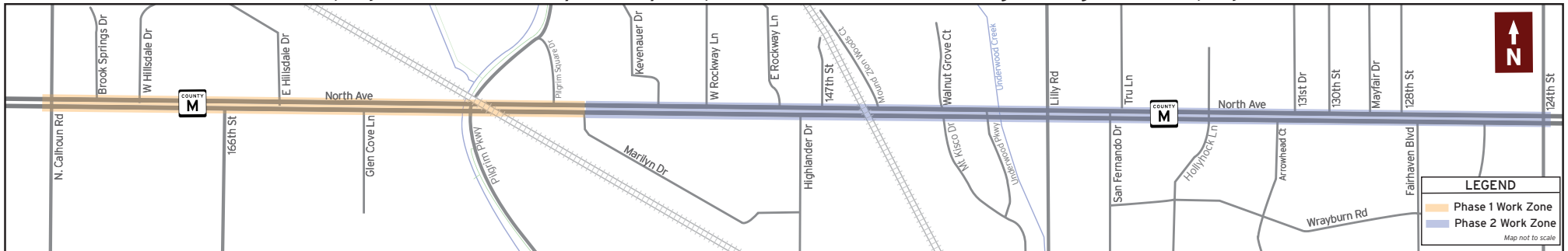
- Reconstruct North Avenue between Marilyn Drive to 124th Street in 2021.

The reconstructed roadway will have two travel lanes, on-street bicycle accommodations, and sidewalks in each direction.
