

Fatal Motor Vehicle Crash – Town of Eagle

On Wednesday, November 6, 2019, at 4:30pm, the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office and Eagle Fire Department responded for a report of a motor vehicle traffic crash on STH 67 north of CTH NN in the Town of Eagle.

Initial investigation revealed that a northbound Ford F-250, operated by a 26 year-old male from Waukesha, crossed the centerline north of CTH NN and struck a southbound Subaru Outback, operated by a 39 year-old female from Waukesha. The operator and sole occupant of the Subaru was pronounced deceased at the crash. The operator and sole occupant of the Ford was transported to Aurora Summit Hospital with serious injuries.

The incident remains under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office and the name of the deceased is being withheld due to pending notification of family. Assistance was received from the Town of Mukwonago, Eagle, and Palmyra Police Departments, Walworth Sheriff, Wisconsin State Patrol, and Troy Center, North Prairie, Eagle, Western Lakes, Mukwonago, and Palmyra Fire Departments.
