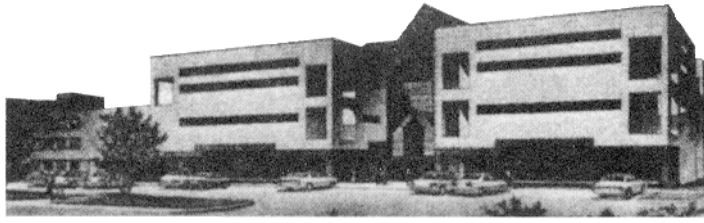

Waukesha County, Wisconsin, December 5-7, 2017: A team of assessors from the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Accreditation Group (WILEAG) will be on-site December 5 through 7, 2017 to examine all aspects of the Waukesha County Sheriff's policies and procedures, management, operations and support services. Agencies are required to comply with all of the standards in these areas to earn accreditation, which is a highly prized recognition of law enforcement professional excellence.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and the public are invited to offer comments by calling 262-896-8137 on December 6, 2017 between 1-2 p.m. Calls will be handled by the WILEAG Assessment Team assigned to conduct the assessment.

Telephone comments are limited to ten minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with WILEAG's standards.
