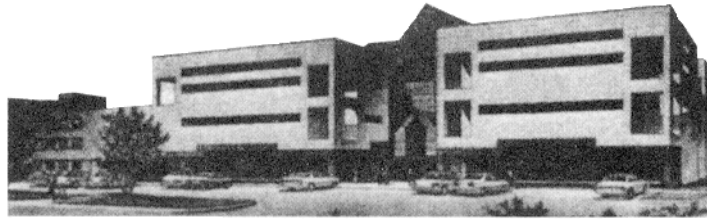

Motor Vehicle Accident – City of Pewaukee

On Thursday November 29, 2018, at approximately 5:44 p.m., the Waukesha County Communications Center received multiple calls regarding a crash on Redford Blvd. at Paul Road in the City of Pewaukee that involved several vehicles. The Waukesha County Sheriff's Office, along with the Wisconsin State Patrol, and the City of Pewaukee Fire Department responded.

Upon arrival, deputies located three vehicles involved in the crash. The initial investigation indicates a single occupant vehicle was driving northbound on Redford Blvd. making a left turn onto Paul Rd. A second single occupant vehicle was driving southbound on Redford Blvd. when it struck the vehicle turning westbound onto Paul Rd. A third single occupant vehicle was involved while waiting at a stop light on Paul Rd. but did not sustain any injury.

A 56-year-old male from the Village of Wales received serious injuries after being ejected from his vehicle and was transported to Froedtert Hospital. A 47-year-old male from the City of Franklin was transported to Waukesha Memorial Hospital for minor injuries.

The accident remains under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office.
