UPDATE

The Waukesha County Sheriff's Office has identified the two deceased individuals that were located at the Meadowbrook Village Condo Complex in the City of Pewaukee. The female is identified as Abigail Voeks, a 27-year-old female from Mukwonago. The male is identified as Zakoree Mitschke, a 30-year-old male from Pewaukee.

This incident is being investigated as a probable homicide/suicide. The incident remains under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office.

Death Investigation – City of Pewaukee

On Tuesday December 5, 2017, the Town of Mukwonago Police Department requested a well-being check for an adult female who did not return to her residence in Mukwonago. At 5:35 p.m., deputies from the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office responded to an address at the Meadowbrook Village Condo Complex in the City of Pewaukee where the female was last believed to be.

While conducting the well-being check at the residence, deputies discovered two deceased adult individuals, one male and one female. Identification of the individuals will not be released until all notifications are made.

This incident is currently under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office.
