### **Bomb Threat at Arrowhead High School**

On Tuesday, February 27, 2018 at 10:30 a.m., the deputy assigned to Arrowhead High School was notified from the staff that there was a written bomb threat located inside the school. A staff member advised the deputy that a student reported seeing what they believed to be a threat inside a room at the South Campus.

After the threat was confirmed by the school administration, they began evacuating the South Campus and moved all students to the North Campus where they were later released for the day.

City of Delafield, Village of Hartland and Village of Chenequa Police Departments as well as the Hartland, Lisbon and Merton Fire Departments responded to the scene to assist. At our request, Milwaukee County Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) K9 Unit responded with three dogs that were utilized to search the South Campus.

Waukesha Sheriff's Deputies and Milwaukee County EOD cleared the building and parking lots; no bomb or any other suspicious items were located. At approximately 2:00 p.m., the Campus was deemed safe and staff started coordination with the students return to retrieve their belongings.

Classes will resume tomorrow.
