Traffic Stop – City of Brookfield

On Monday, February 26, 2018, at 9:08 p.m., a Deputy from the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office initiated a traffic stop westbound on I-94 at South Calhoun Road. During the course of the investigation, a second Waukesha Sheriff's Deputy arrived to assist and the two male occupants from the traffic stop were subsequently taken into custody. The operator was arrested for operating a motor vehicle while under the influence as well as other drug related charges. The passenger was also arrested on drug related charges and both subjects were transported to the local hospital for medical clearance as a precautionary measure.

During a search of the vehicle, both Deputies were exposed to an unknown substance located in the vehicle. One of the deputies was administered Narcan at the scene and both deputies were transported to a local hospital as a precautionary measure and later released.

A portion of I-94 westbound was closed for several hours while the investigation continued. Wisconsin State Patrol, City of Brookfield Fire Department, Waukesha County Metropolitan Drug Unit and Wisconsin Department of Criminal Investigations (DCI) were on the scene to assist in the investigation.

This matter remains under investigation by the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office.
